Inspired by the international tradition of uncut cloth and by medical images of the heart. Woven rectangles are present in many cultures as shawls, stoles, wraps, saris, scarves, etc. The fine striations of cardiac muscle, stained red for microscopic examination, and the pink

grid-like structure of woven cloth, broken by the disorderly tracing of a heart in trouble.
