

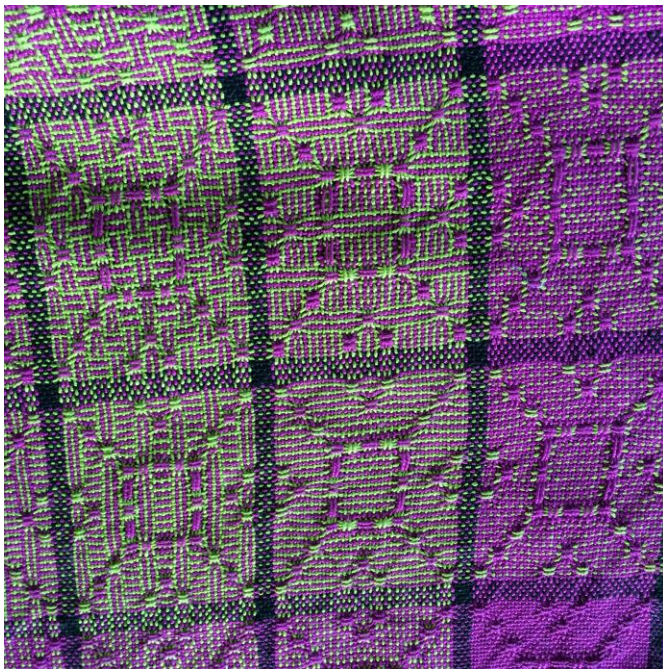

Dates: Friday, Saturday, & Sunday, March 10,11,12, 2017 9am-4pm daily

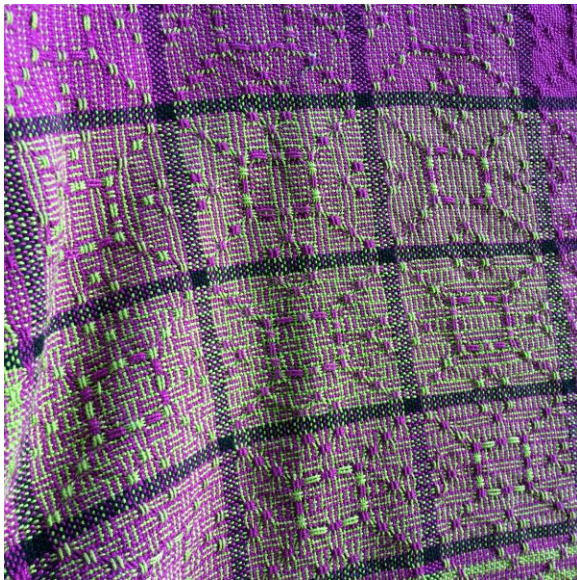
Place: Ft. Caroline Community Center, Jacksonville, FL

Description: "Huck has always been one of my favorite of weave structures. When I one day applied color and weave effects to the threading the resulting fabric was nothing less than wonderful. The patterns were bold and striking and yet still had the feeling of

beautiful lace. In the workshop you will see how simple color sequencing applied to a threading such as Huck can change how you think about weaving fabric. You will ask yourself, "if this works so well for Huck, what other weave structures will benefit from color and weave"? You will receive a threading draft several weeks before the start of class. Here you will find the warp broken up into several different color sequences that when woven will knock your socks off. Dozens of fabric patterns are possible in this workshop and the final piece will look wonderful on your table or wall" (Tom Knisely)
